

## **THE ALLIED BUILDING METAL INDUSTRIES, INC. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

1. This Scholarship Program is open to all graduating high school seniors and high school graduates who are either full time employees, or sons or daughters of full time employees, of a member firm of Allied Building Metal Industries, Inc. or of a contributing employer to the industry's advancement funds. Included as eligible applicants are members in good standing, and children of members in good standing of Structural Iron Workers Local Unions Nos. 40 and 361 and of Ornamental Iron Workers Local Union No. 580.

No owner or children of owners of Allied members or of contributing employers are eligible nor are any paid officers or agents of the aforementioned labor organizations or their children. In certain limited instances, applications will be accepted from students already enrolled in college or other educational institutions described below.

2. Scholarships will be awarded to those attending, or planning to attend, on a full time basis any accredited college, university, junior college, technical, or trade school located in the United States. Please note that preference will be given to those applicants pursuing a degree in architecture, engineering or any other vocation directly related to the construction industry.
3. Scholarship awards are competitive and will be based on, among other things:
  - Academic standing of the student;
  - Recent college entrance examination (SAT) scores;
  - Extracurricular activities and leadership;
  - Character references;
  - Type of program being pursued;
  - Any other information deemed pertinent by the Selection Committee.

Each candidate must be willing to accept the decision of the Selection Committee as final and binding. The Selection Committee reserves the right to interpret all rules and regulations regarding this Scholarship Program and any decision made by said Committee is final and irrevocable.

4. Six scholarships will be awarded each year. Scholarships awarded will be for a maximum of four years. Three of these scholarships will be awarded for 25% of the school's tuition charges up to a maximum of \$2000.00 per year. The remaining scholarships shall be awarded for 25% of the school's tuition charges up to a maximum of \$1000.00 per year. In order to retain his/her scholarship such student must maintain satisfactory progress toward completion of the program of study. Students must maintain at least a C average in order to be considered for scholarship renewal. Such students must apply for renewal on their scholarship each year by May 31<sup>st</sup> prior to the academic year to which the renewal application refers.\* Renewal applications must be accompanied by an official school transcript.

5. Applicants for other than renewal scholarships must submit a completed application, which can be obtained from the office of Allied Building Metal Industries, Inc., to such office at 211 East 43<sup>rd</sup> Street, New York, New York 10017 by April 30<sup>th</sup> prior to the academic year to which the application refers.\*
6. The Selection Committee retains the right to revise, change or cancel the Scholarship Awards Program at any time without prior notice.

\*For example the application for the academic year 2002-2003 is due on May 31, 2002 for a renewal and April 30, 2002 for an initial application.
